- 1. All hams & bacons will be checked in Sunday, July 21, noon to 2 p.m. on the **east side** of exhibit building. Exhibit tags will be placed on the ham/bacon when checked in.
- 2. Judging to be held Monday, July 22, 8 a.m. until finished. Exhibitors welcome to attend & watch judging any questions will be answered only after the judge makes final decisions, 3 p.m. or after.
- 3. Decision of the judges are final.
- 4. Maximum of two hams/slabs of bacon may be shown, only highest point ham/bacon allowed to sell.
- 5. Bacons must be shown as a full slab.
- 6. Only USDA inspected hams/bacon of blue or red ribbon quality are allowed to be sold, hams must weigh a minimum of 12 lbs. & a maximum of 30 lbs.
- 7. PROFESSIONALLY TRIMMED OR OTHERWISE COMMERCIALLY PREPARED HAMS/BACONS ARE PROHIBITED FROM 4-H & FFA COMPETITON. ALL HAMS/BACONS MUST BE CURED AND TRIMMED BY THE EXHIBITOR.
- 8. Refrigeration will be available for bacons.
- 9. Exhibitors that wish to sell their ham/bacon in the premium auction must be present at the auction to sell their ham/bacon.
- 10. To sell a ham/bacon in the premium auction, all ham/bacon project participants are required to either: show a livestock project at the fair, participate in shooting sports with a minimum requirement of 10 hours of practice, or have at least 3 exhibits for judging in addition to a ham/bacon project submission, excluding open shows.
- 11. Intent to sell cards must be turned in to the superintendent on the day of check in. Exhibitors cannot sell both an animal and a ham/bacon. Members allowed in the sale ring only once in 2024.
- 12. Hams/bacons will become the property of the buyer immediately after the premium sale.
- 13.4-H Council, FFA, nor the Fair Board will be responsible for sold or unsold hams/bacons not picked up by posted time after the sale. Unclaimed hams/bacons will be donated. Pick up is Thursday evening after the completion of the livestock/ham/bacon sale.
