All animals, any breed including dairy steers, must have been born between January 1st last year and September 1st last year. Animal is to be verified by 4-H leader or FFA advisor. Each steer will be mouthed to determine age. Must have baby teeth. Animal is to be born on a family member's farm in Cooper County to be considered home raised.
