We are excited to have this opportunity for the 4-H and FFA members to offer their handmade and homegrown products to the public. We will have a Youth Market set up on the Fairgrounds during the fair, every evening from 5PM to 8pm.

1. Any item made by the youth, with the exception of those that are in the exhibition building this year, including: Arts and crafts, photos, machinery, woodworking items, vegetables, eggs, baked goods, plants etc, may be included.
2. A total of 10 items per youth may be displayed at one time. If items sell, they can be replaced. It is up to the youth to check their inventory and replace items as needed.
3. Items must be checked/logged in with Lynn Bishop Perera before they will be displayed. At log in, items will be tagged with name, price and description of the item. Each youth will be assigned a vendor # that will also be included on the tag.
4. In order to be allowed to sell their items, each youth will be required to sign up and work the Market for 1 hour during the fair.

This could be a great opportunity for those kids that have worked so hard for so many years on projects, to reap some rewards.
