

OPEN BUCKET CALF

No health papers required

Entry Friday 8 a.m. – Judging Friday 9 a.m.

This Bucket Calf class is designed for boys and girls under 8 years of age as of January 1, of current year. Walking toddlers and any age child under 8 will be allowed to show if he/she shows the ability to control the calf and is able to show alone in the ring. Limit 1 animal per entrant.

Class requirements are as follows:

1. Own a calf born between March 1 and May 1 of the current year.
2. Calf must be owned and fed on a bottle before the calf is two weeks of age. The calf cannot nurse a cow after the calf is two weeks old.
3. No health papers required.
4. Entrant must take care of the calf. Care is to include feeding, training calf to lead, and looking after the calf's health.
5. **The bobby calf will not be eligible for the livestock sale or for any other class at the County Livestock Show.**
6. The calf can be beef, dairy, or a cross of beef and dairy, steer or heifer. **No bull calves.**
7. The showing style will be according to the breed shown.
8. Depending on the number of entrants, class may be broken into subclasses based on the breed of animal or age of entrants.
9. The judge will interview each entrant to determine the entrant's knowledge.
