

## Cooper County Fair - Open Shows

- 1.) OPEN MARKET BARROW, GILT AND BREEDING GILT SWINE SHOW: A special open market barrow and gilt swine class AND BREEDING GILT SHOW will be open to all counties and all ages 5 and older. Entries should be in place at the fairgrounds by 8 am Saturday, 7-23 with all being released following the show. This class will be judged on Saturday at 9 am. Pens are not provided. \$20 entry fee, prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place when there are 4 or more entries
- 2.) OPEN DAIRY GOAT SHOW: A special open dairy goat show will be open to all counties and all ages 5 and older. Entries must be ADGA and/or AGS registered. Health papers must be on site. Entries should be in place Saturday 7-23 with all being released following the show. Pens are not provided. This class will be judged on Saturday after the open swine breeding gilt show. \$10 entry fee, prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place when there are 4 or more entries.
- 3.) OPEN MARKET AND BREEDING SHEEP & GOAT SHOW: A special open market and breeding sheep and goat show will be open to all counties and all ages 5 and older. Health papers must be on site. Entries should be in place Saturday 7-23 with all being released following the show. Pens are not provided. This class will be judged on Saturday after the open dairy goat show. \$20 entry fee, prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place when there are 4 or more entries
- 4.) OPEN STEER & MARKET HEIFER SHOW: A special open steer and market heifer class will be open to all counties and all ages 5 and older. This class will be judged on Saturday following the open market and breeding sheep & goat show. Steers & Market Heifers must be part of the current year's program and meet standard eligibility rules for age and ownership. Stalls are not provided. Steers & Market Heifers must be brought to the fair on Saturday 7-23, entry beginning at 8 am with all being released following the show. \$20 entry fee, prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place when there are 4 or more entries.
- 5.) OPEN BEEF BREEDING HEIFER SHOW: Open to all counties and all ages 5 and older. Entries should be in place at the fairgrounds on Saturday, 7-23 with all being released following the show. Stalls are not provided. This class will be judged on Saturday after the open steer and market heifer show. \$20 entry fee, prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place when there are 4 or more entries.
